This quarter, I have updates/information on a number of different topics:

LMSC Development

 Relay 2024 and the National Coaches Clinic (NCC) will be held together for the first time on Oct 18-20 in Houston. The focus for Relay 2024 is Community Development. An ALTS (water-portion) class will be held on Friday afternoon at the hotel. USMS is asking for subsidy requests for Relay and NCC. LMSC/Zone + Board of Directors Conversations - Kenny Brisbin and I will be meeting with as many volunteer leaders in the NW Zone as possible to have our annual BOD/Local Conversation. We'd love to hold this between June 11th and July 31st. We'll send a poll of some sort to collect availability from the LMSC Chairs and then extend the invite to all others.

Membership is looking good compared to this time last year, Grown-Up Swimming has opened registration in some leagues and College Club Swimming ended with 1,250 participants higher than 2023.

The focus of Volunteer Relay (October 18-20 - Houston, TX) is "Community Development" which is really broad and can appeal and apply to several volunteers in LMSCs. I hope you are working on identifying people to attend. A nice tie-in is that the National Coaches Clinic will be held in parallel with Relay. Make sure you are soliciting coaches to attend the NCC and helping with LMSC resources.

LaneMate - be sure to look for the Streamlines announcement and overview of this new program offering targeted for the Independent Swimmer who doesn't have access to a club or can't make the swim practice times. Some of the benefits will be offered to traditional USMS members for an additional fee. The rollout of LaneMate is intentionally coinciding with interest in the Olympics.

Recent and/or upcoming events:

- The **2024 MT State SCY Championship Meet** was held the weekend of **April 6-7, 2024**, at the Butte Family YMCA, Butte, MT. Fifty-two swimmers participated and 24 new state records were set. In conjunction with the meet, the LMSC hosted a social and the 2024 Annual Meeting on Saturday night.
- Swimmers also participated in two dual-sanctioned meets: the **2024 GAC/KATS Splash Pentathlon** (SCY) in Kalispell, MT in January and the **2024 Spring Chicken First Splash** (LCM) in Bozeman, MT in April.

Notable news:

Montana Masters swimmer, **Charlotte Sanddal**, passed away on February 19th, 2024, at the age of 101. On the weekend of April 6-7th, swimmers from across the state had Charlotte in their hearts as they competed in the 2024 Champs, a meet that Charlotte herself competed in just one year prior at age 100. Charlotte was honored at the meet with a moment of silence, and, at the social event after the first day of swimming, many stories were shared to help keep Charlotte's legacy alive. Members of the Helena Ridleys workout group wore matching "Charlotte Shirts" to pay tribute to their late team member. Charlotte was an inspiration to many and, as someone who started swimming in her 70s, a true testament to the idea that it is never too late to try something new. Charlotte currently holds 94 Montana state records, 21 USMS records, and four World Aquatics records.

Peggy Stringer, coach of the Helena Ridleys, shared the following on Charlotte, whom she thought of like a sister: "The Helena Ridleys gives out a traveling Charlotte Sanddal inspirational swimmer award annually to the most inspirational Ridley swimmer. Charlotte was the first swimmer to receive the award in 2017. The award is a silver wine cooler because Charlotte loved Chardonnay. Some say her love for Chardonnay helped her live to 101, but the truth is swimming helped her live to be 101. You always wanted Charlotte on your team. She swam as many events as possible and she usually placed first in her age group, scoring the most points for her team. Her swimming looked effortless, but she always worked hard. She swam all the hardest events."

Charlotte was also honored by USA Swimming at the MT Swimming Short Course State Championships in February.
